# truckee river ARTS DISTRICT

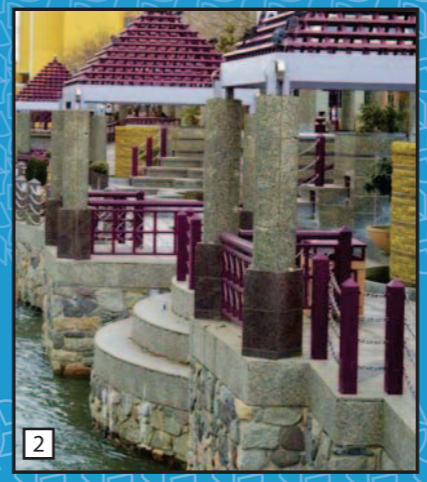

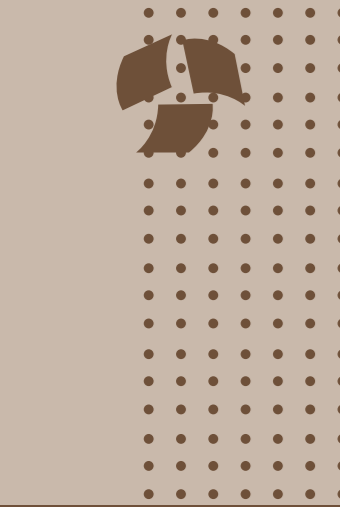
