LOCATION:

50 East Fourth Street, Reno, Nev.
Located in the heart of downtown, adjacent to the National Bowling Stadium and the Reno Events Center, within walking distance of more than 6,600 hotel rooms and a 10-minute drive from the Reno-Tahoe International Airport.

GENERAL:

The new, dramatic and largest ballroom in downtown Reno offers 28,000 square feet of luxurious and versatile meeting space. Accommodating more than 1,900 for an elaborate dinner and 2,900 for a general session, the Ballroom augments the adjacent 56,000-square-foot Reno Events Center, which accommodates 371 10' x 10' exhibit booths.
