RENO EVENTS CENTER - FACT SHEET

LOCATION:	<p>400 N. Center St., Reno, Nev. Located in the heart of downtown adjacent to the National Bowling Stadium and the Downtown Reno Ballroom (opening Jan. 2008) within walking distance of more than 6,600 hotel rooms and a 10-minute drive from the Reno-Tahoe International Airport.</p>
MANAGEMENT:	<p>The Reno Events Center (REC) is owned by the city of Reno and managed by the Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority (RSCVA). It is a public-private partnership between the City of Reno, RSCVA and NEWCO, comprised of four downtown properties including Circus Circus Reno, Harrah's Reno, Silver Legacy Resort Casino and Eldorado Hotel and Casino.</p> <p>The REC is one of four major meeting facility operated by the RSCVA. The others include: the National Bowling Stadium, Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center, and the Reno-Sparks Convention Center.</p>
OVERALL SPACE:	<p>The facility offers a total of 118,000 square feet of space.</p>
TOTAL SEATING CAPACITY:	<p>7,500 seats split among telescopic stadium seating, balcony and floor.</p>
FIRST FLOOR SPACE:	<p>The facility has 56,000 square feet of multipurpose floor space, accommodating concerts, sporting events, large dinners or small conventions and trade shows. It offers retractable, telescopic stadium seating.</p>
SECOND FLOOR SPACE:	<p>The REC is packed with high-tech equipment including retractable air walls, which allow configuration of ten meeting space or suite rooms ranging from 400 to 825 square feet for a total of 4,954 square feet of available space. Additional balcony seating is located outside the suites and is able to accommodate 264 in three rows.</p>
AMENITIES:	<p>Center amenities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Four first floor snack bars, one of which includes a full-service kitchen• Escalator access to second-floor suites• Utility elevator to second-floor suites• Three loading docks <p>-more-</p>
